Enagás has reached an agreement to acquire 22.38% of Transportadora de Gas del Peru (TgP), contingent upon the remaining shareholders not exercising their rights of first refusal

Enagás has reached an agreement to acquire 22.38% of Transportadora de Gas del Peru, S.A. (TgP), a stake held by Hunt and Repsol, amounting to 491 million dollars. The deal is contingent upon the remaining TgP shareholders not exercising their rights of first refusal.

TgP transmits the lion's share of Peru's natural gas and gas condensate and owns a gas pipeline that takes natural gas from the Camisea fields to the Melchorita liquefaction plant, the only LNG export terminal in Peru.

Enagás seeks to participate in projects that make Peru's energy supply more secure. Likewise, this agreement is in keeping with the criteria laid out in Enagás' 2013-2015 Strategic Update and fits its core business, as well as its profitability and debt targets.

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
