

Corporate directives in connection with Road Safety

- Endeavour to reduce traffic accidents and the deaths and injuries they cause and the negative impact caused to our society.
- Foster the creation of communication channels and collaboration with the competent road safety authorities; encourage and take part in initiatives that assist their efforts.
- Contribute to the work of informing and raising awareness of road safety in people and organisations within the scope of your competence.
- Become familiar with the mobility habits of Enagás' employees; assess and manage the risks in work-related travel, including the risks inherent to your facilities; and put forward preventive measures to reduce proportion of work-related accidents attributed to traffic accidents, in order to guarantee the road safety of workers as far as this is reasonably possible.
- Incorporate your employees' mobility-related risks into Health and Safety management.
- Appropriately disseminate the road safety action plan; facilitate knowledge of its contents to all parts of the organisation and their involvement.
- Incorporate the road safety culture into the company's Occupational Health and Safety Plan.
- Create conditions in which work-related travel can be safe.

- Reinforce safe driving skills by means of training and regular information for drivers.
- Keep your fleet of vehicles equipped with state of the art technology for safety and ergonomics.
- Comply with legal requirements and all road safety-related agreements by which Enagás is bound.
- Support road safety as part of the Enagás integral policy for the welfare, health and safety of the company's employees.
- Constantly update and improve the Road Safety Management System; set specific targets and mechanisms for the measurement of system performance, detection of deviations and implementation of suitable corrective measures.
- Keep these guidelines effective by reviewing them regularly.
