As a continuation of the Operation Note 05/2018, and considering the current forecasts of the State Meteorological Agency, the **Cold Snap period started on March 17 is extended until further notice**, according to the criteria defined in the Action Plan winter for the operation of the gas system of 27 November, 2017.

The predicted temperatures give rise to an extraordinary increase with respect to the expected values under normal conditions of 1,250 GWh from the beginning of the Cold Wave on March 17 until Friday March 23, the period of maximum reliability of the forecasts.

In accordance with the Winter Action Plan for the operation of the gas system and until further notice, it remains:

EXCEPTION OPERATING SITUATION – LEVEL ZERO- COLD SNAP from 06.00 a.m. on March 17th and until further notice.


