Unavailability at REGANOSA LNG Terminal in MUGARDOS due to an incident in its transportation network. **EXCEPTIONAL OPERATING SITUATION (SOE) –2**

Due to an incident in the Reganosa transmission network in the Galicia area, since June 1, 2022, the Mugardos regasification plant has ceased its emission to the network.

The GTS is adopting the necessary measures to guarantee maximum demand coverage in the affected area, maximizing transportation from the rest of the System. Thus, the area of Galicia and Asturias is fed through the Ruta de la Plata gas pipeline, the Burgos-Santander-Asturias gas pipeline and the Tuy International Connection. Maintenance operations in neighboring areas have also been postponed.

Given that Reganosa's repair forecast for the aforementioned incident exceeds 48 hours with respect to its start, and given the high demand that is being registered in the area, in order to control the pressures in the area until the restart of the emission of the Mugardos plant, the limitation of consumption is required and an EXCEPTIONAL LEVEL 2 OPERATING SITUATION is declared.

Following the minimum intervention principle, it is guaranteed the 100% of the conventional demand as well as the electric consumption of 20 GWh/d for the CCGT located in Galicia and 4 GWh/d for the CCGT located in Asturias for the 2nd of jun. These quantities have been agreed with the technical manager of the electric System, being the aforementioned quantities the minimums necessaries to guarantee the security of supply of the electric system.

As a preventive measure to guarantee demand coverage, additional contracting will be limited to delivery commitments in the Zamora-Oviedo-Tuy gas pipeline due to a lack of temporary transportation capacity from today.

If there are variations in the input-output balance or in the the rest of the variables involved in the affected area, this operation note will be updated in the coming days.
