Elements to take in account in a power of attorney

- 1. Carry out the necessary formalities to obtain user authorisation for the company to access the Spanish gas system facilities and/or use or withdraw from the balancing portfolios it is interested in according to its operations in the system.
- 2. Carry out the necessary formalities to the identification and authentication of users for access to the information systems of Enagás and of access and use of the SL-ATR system.
- 3. Carry out the necessary formalities to request user balancing portfolio grouping.
- 4. Digitally sign the contracts indicated in the foregoing faculties, for which purpose they are entitled to use any qualified electronic signature certificate issued by an entity recognised in the European Union.

Duration of the power of attorney:

(*)If the power of attorney is granted abroad, the law governing and interpreting it must be specified.

(**) The power of attorney will be drawn up in Spanish and, in the case of companies with their registered office outside Spanish territory, must include the Hague Apostille.
